Sue suggested to use the Affinity Check to pay for the printing; all agreed.
B. Regional Expo Plans Aug. $10^{\text {th }}$, Enosburg Opera House - Expo is still on. Pat, Sue, Elsie and Parma went to Swanton earlier to check out the Regional Historical Society Meeting and came away with much knowledge and the exchange of relevant information.
