

Montgomery Historical Society Chair Receives Award of Merit

The Montgomery Historical Society's Chairman, Scott Perry was recognized by the Vermont Historical Society (VHS) and League of Local Historical Societies (LLHS) for exceptional contributions to the Montgomery Society at its annual meeting held November 2nd in Woodstock, VT. His Board of Directors nominated him citing his success in numerous Society initiatives, including community outreach, an award winning web site, and preservation of Pratt Hall, the Town's former Episcopal Church completed in 1835.

In making the presentation, Mark Hudson, Executive Director of the Vermont Historical Society, noted the appreciation of the Board for "making the meetings fun" and his great enthusiasm and leadership over the past nine years as Chairman. The MHS has won nine LLHS awards since 2007.

In accepting the award Perry thanked his high school history teacher, his remarkable Board of Directors, and his wife, for their inspiration and support. He noted his wife, Sharon, has spent two of her last six birthdays at these meetings.
